

Good to Know!!

Day Trip Registration 2021-2022

- Before registering, please read Ski/Snowshoe Covid-19 Guidelines.
- Pre-register and pre-pay on-line, for all day trips.
- Registration opens the first of the month prior to the date of the trip. For example, you can register in November for all trips in December. Starting December 1st, you can register for all trips taking place in January...and so on.
- If a trip is full, please go on the wait list.
- The bus fare is paid on-line when you register. When you register a week or more in advance, the Early Bird fare is \$25.00. When you register after this, bus fares are \$27.50. All non-members pay \$27.50. ***Please note** that bus fares may still be subject to change.
- Trail fees are also paid on-line when you register. Ski/snowshoe trail pass fees for 2021/22 are not yet determined.
- You can register up to midnight on the Thursday before a Saturday trip. You can register up to midnight on Friday for a Sunday trip. The same principle applies to a midweek trip.
- Registration for Ski Better Clinics (Level 2 and 3) is the same as for day trips. Registration for Level 1 Lessons is different. (see document "All About Ski Lessons" on the "Ski & Snowshoe Day Trip and Lessons" page of the website).

Day Trip Cancellations

- You must call or e-mail Cheryl McCarney (Club Manager) if you need to cancel a trip. There is no self serve cancellation on-line. Phone: 905 634-2012 or info@haltonoutdoorclub.ca
- If you cancel a day trip more than **4 days prior to departure** or if the club cancels a trip due to poor conditions, you will receive a refund within a few days.
- If you experience Covid-like symptoms at any point prior to the trip, you may cancel without penalty.
- If you cancel **less than 4 days prior to departure** for any other reason, you will receive a refund for the Trail Fee portion of the registration, but you will be charged for the Bus Fare portion of the registration, unless the Club Manager can fill the spot with someone from the waitlist. If a replacement is found, you will receive a full refund.
- Always check the website for last minute changes: go to "Events Cancellations and Updates". Sometimes we need to make changes to destinations or cancel a trip due to poor weather or trail conditions.

Lessons

- Registration for Ski Better Clinics Level 2 and 3 take place at the same time you register for the day trip.
- Cancellation policies for the Ski Better Clinics Level 2 and 3 are the same as for the day trips.
